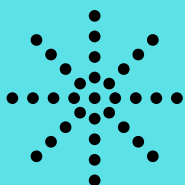
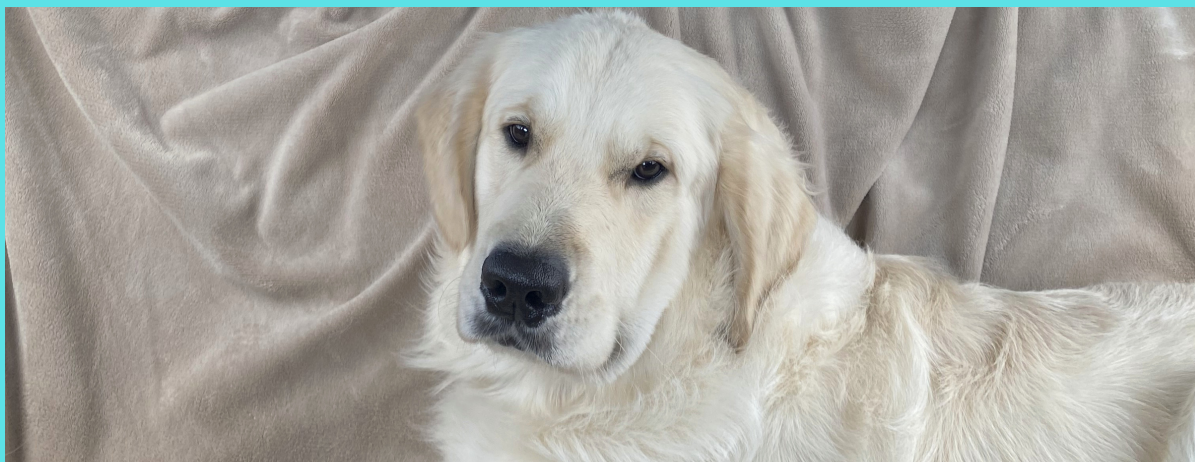

While the year brought many unique challenges, Rockbridge Animal Alliance finished 2023 strong.

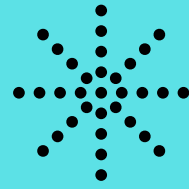

THE YEAR IN REVIEW



Thanks to the support of our community and national organizations, we are helping many local families and their pets continue to share their lives together. As a result, more vulnerable pets in our area are safe.

Regardless of their pet's age, breed, size, or needs we continue to be a safety net to assist pet owners with supplemental pet food and veterinarian interventions.

Shelters and rescues across the United States are in crisis. There are

more dogs and cats entering the shelters than leaving. This motivates our desire to uphold our mission of keeping pets and families together. Assisting pet parents to establish a relationship with local veterinarians was an essential goal in 2023.

Inflation has impacted the cost of pet food with prices rising 14-15%. Yet, we continued to work hard so that local at-risk pets were able to receive the nourishment they deserve. We successfully distributed over **10 tons of pet food**.

Winter Highlight

In November, we received \$6500 in grants from Washington & Lee University, the Community Foundation for Rockbridge, Bath, and Allegheny Counties, and the Ursula Landsrath Foundation in support of our spay & neuter program. In January 2024, we will receive \$6000 from Two Mauds.

Summer Highlight

On June 4, 2023 we held our first Wags & Whiskers Fundraiser. The event was held at Great Valley Brewery & Winery, and we were able to raise \$5800 that was shared with Furever Friends Lodge. In August, we received \$1000 from Walmart.

Autumn Highlight

In September, we held our first Photo Calendar contest which resulted in 118 participants and raised \$3324.52. The 2024 Calendar, available for sale, was stunning with lots of smiling furbabies. In October, Heliotrope Brewery raised \$529.60 for RAA.

Spring Highlight

This Spring, senior dogs were given a boost through the Grey Muzzle \$1500 grant we received. The grant allowed us to provide wellness exams and treatment to many deserving seniors who may otherwise gone untreated.

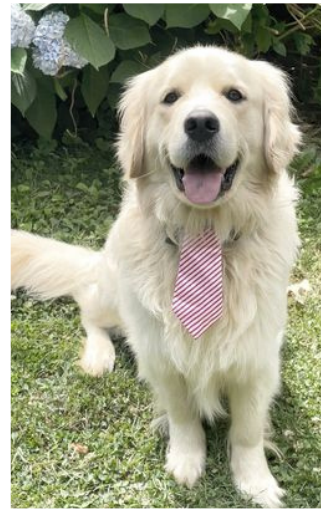
